What will be learning about this half term?

English	Maths	Reading
In English we will be reading and writing effective story openers, using rhetorical questions, repetition, unanswered questions, ellipsis etc. Then we will read and write effective character descriptions, using similes, metaphors and personification. The final English unit will look at planning and writing a sequel. In reciprocal reading we will be studying the Iron Man by Ted Hughes. In Grammar we will recap on all the Y4 objectives including fronted adverbials, expanded noun phrases with adjectives and prepositions, inverted commas for speech, pronouns, and apostrophes.	In maths we will be looking at two topics. Firstly, we will be working on fractions (equivalent fractions, adding and subtracting fractions, using decimals and dividing by hundredths and tenths). Finally, we will be working on calculation policies for addition, subtraction and using a formal written method for multiplication and division.	In reciprocal reading this half term we will be reading The Iron Man. We will look at a variety of areas within novel including characters, setting descriptions, understanding why the author has used certain vocabulary to catch the reader's interest and imagination, and making predictions based on evidence from the text.
Computing	PE	Music
In I.C.T we will be researching the Mediterranean and using the internet to find out a variety of facts and information that we can then present and share to the rest of the class.	In P.E we will be getting ready for Sports Day and taking part in lessons that focus on a variety of track and field events.	Y4 Gryphons will have flute lessons every Friday morning. This term Y4 will be continuing to study the genre of hip hop. Through the songs we listen to we will be learning to identify the key elements of music, and to compare and contrast the pieces we will be studying. We will be improvising and composing using our recorders, flutes and clarinets- so please have these in school each week. We will also be extending our song repertoire with songs using the extended pentatonic scale.

Researching venetian masks. Then designing, drawing, making and decorating masks.	In Theme we will be looking at the Mediterranean and why it is so popular with tourists. We will focus on a variety of areas such as the countries located there, the food, the weather and what interesting things there are to see and do there whilst on holiday.	We will be looking at the concept of taking care of the environment that we live in (linking to Theme) and looking at ways to reflect on our recent achievements and areas to improve on for the upcoming year.

PE Kits: Please make sure your child has a labelled PE kit in school. PE kits should stay in school for the whole half term and come home to be washed in the holidays.

If despite this, they still struggle and we feel they may need some additional support with their learning, we would discuss appropriate steps with you in consultation with Miss Collard our Inclusion Leader.
